





Breast cancer followed by cervical cancer are the two most common cancers among women in India, but actually they are largely preventable diseases. Awareness surrounding breast and cervical cancer is incredibly important as early detection, often through screening, can catch the disease when it is most treatable and also prevention by making necessary changes in lifestyle.

The Objectives of this Cancer Awareness Program is to create cancer awareness and remove the stigma and fear attached.

- I. Help women recognize the early signs and symptoms of cancer, thus enabling them to seek treatment at an early stage.
- 2. Educate people about the key risk factors, since more than 30% of cancer cases could be prevented by modifying lifestyle or avoiding the risk factors.
- Inform women about the importance of self-exam, regular screening, mammogram and Pap smear tests to check for signs of cancer.

Followed by the lecture there will be a screening, clinical examination and cervical pap smear examination.
