



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

#### INTRODUCTION


Mentor Mentee Program is an vital component for an Institute, as it bridges the gap between the faculties and students. Mentoring provides students emotional, instrumental support, guidance, encouragement and better environment in the institute. A mentor plays a vital role in nurturing students and has a positive impact on students academic achievement. A mentee can approach his / her mentor for both educational and personal guidance. It is conducted to help the students to strengthen their varied capabilities and to build an interpersonal relationship between the faculties and students.

### AIMS OF MENTORSHIP PROGRAM

 To enhance students educational, social and personal growth through learning from the experience of mentors

### **OBJECTIVES OF MENTORSHIP PROGRAM**

- Mentors may perform a variety of roles, such as model, advisor, friend, teacher and resource person. These roles serve many functions in the mentor-mentee relationships.
- They can bring profound changes to the mentees' social, professional and academic perspectives.



Mentors may act as a coach by giving advice, suggestions and guidance to the mentees about their career planning and advancement in future.

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
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- Mentors may help mentees understand some real life experience in the workplace and integrate their theoretical learning with practical examples in the field.
- Providing assistance in academic and non-academic matters.
- Motivate and helping students to focus on achieving their learning objectives that increases their academic performance.
- Provide students with guidance, encouragement, and counsel regarding their imminent life such as their mental and emotional well-being.
- To listen to the concerns of students with patience and supporting them to resolve their issues.
- Encouraging and instigating students' interest and enthusiasm in academics, co curricular and extracurricular activities

### **DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES OF A MENTOR:**

- To encourage Mentee personal and professional growth.
- To enhance leadership and management skills of Mentee.
- Help Mentee to connect to the Institute in a deeper, more meaningful way.
- To Expose Mentee to the emerging talent pool.
- Provide career guidance and advice on transition from classroom to workplace.
- To set a professional distinction as someone who can serve as an example and role model for others.
- To develop the interpersonal skills needed for future dentist-patient relationships.
- To improve relationships with colleagues and superiors.

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- Mentor should maintain a log book and should record all the details of the Mentee
- Mentor should allocate appropriate time and interact with Mentee frequently.
- Meet the Mentee face-to-face (one interaction per month) and enter the details of the meeting in the log book.
  - Monitor Mentees attendance and all Academic activities.
- Mentor should collect the details of attendance and Internal Assessment from respective Department or from mentee and maintain the record of the same in the log book.
  - Once in three months conduct Parent-Teacher meetings either online or offline mode and maintain the records for the same.
  - Intimate HOD and suggest if any administrative action is called for.

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
