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1. This and any to be revised shall be conducted under the terms of the agreement under clause (1) and further subject to satisfactory performance and evaluation by DDC.

2. **Financial provisions and management of funds:** As the approach to project activities will be joint activity in the second party Dental College shall have liability of last monthly reports to the DDC Health & Family Welfare Officer and Deputy Director Oral Health Policy and Dental Health particularly to be agreed by both the parties. The payments to the College shall be made into two instalments in a monthly basis after a pending two months report and invoice through faculty.

3. The second party shall not make any change without prior approval from the Commissioner, Health & Family Welfare Department, and Government of Karnataka. Changes in the fee form shall not alter the main purpose of the project and shall be done only to ensure smooth implementation of the agreed project goals.

4. **Faculty facilities such as:** (1) The acquisition of surgical, Professional, etc. will be the responsibility of the Member Services, Oral Health Policy, and the dentures will be made accordingly as applicable.

- Dental College shall conduct dental outreach camps in accordance with approved Oral Health Policy Objectives and Dental Health Initiatives to extend the reach of the project. The College shall submit the Dental Outreach Report to the Government of India and Government of Karnataka.
- Dental College shall not charge any cost of dental services such as OPD cost charges or consultation fees, etc. The scheme shall not include the cost of drug, materials and other hospital expenses needed to be compensated through insurance, any beneficiary having a free treatment shall be subject to such situation in any other state provisions intended to treatment plan to ensure of comprehensive services shall be free of cost including both extraction.

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

9. Tenure and Termination

This MoU will take effect from the date it is signed by representatives of the two institutions. It will remain valid for three years, and may be continued thereafter after suitable review and agreement. Either institution may terminate the MoU by giving written notice to the other institution six months in advance. Once terminated, neither KCP nor MRADCH will be responsible for any losses, financial or otherwise, which the other institutions may suffer. 10. Dispute Resolution

The decision of the arbitrator shall be final and binding upon both parties.
