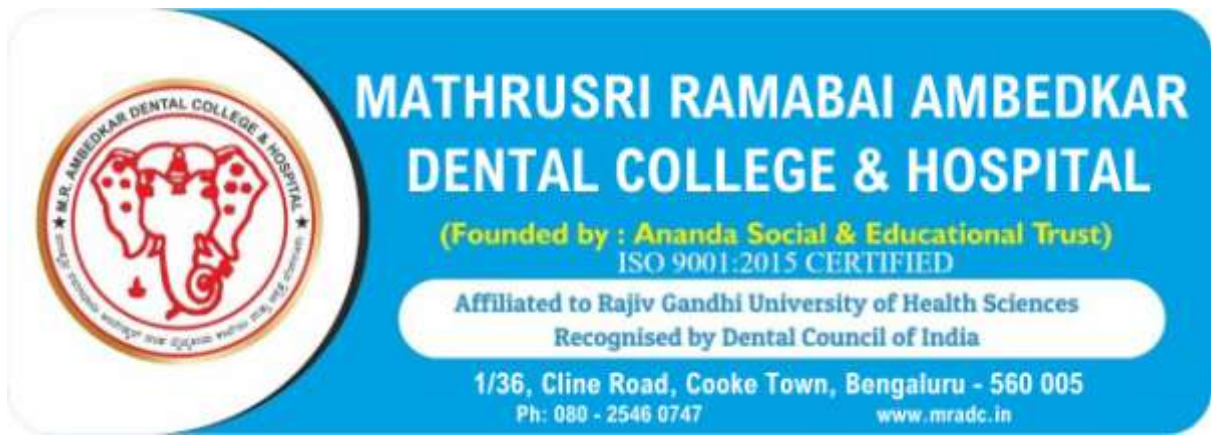

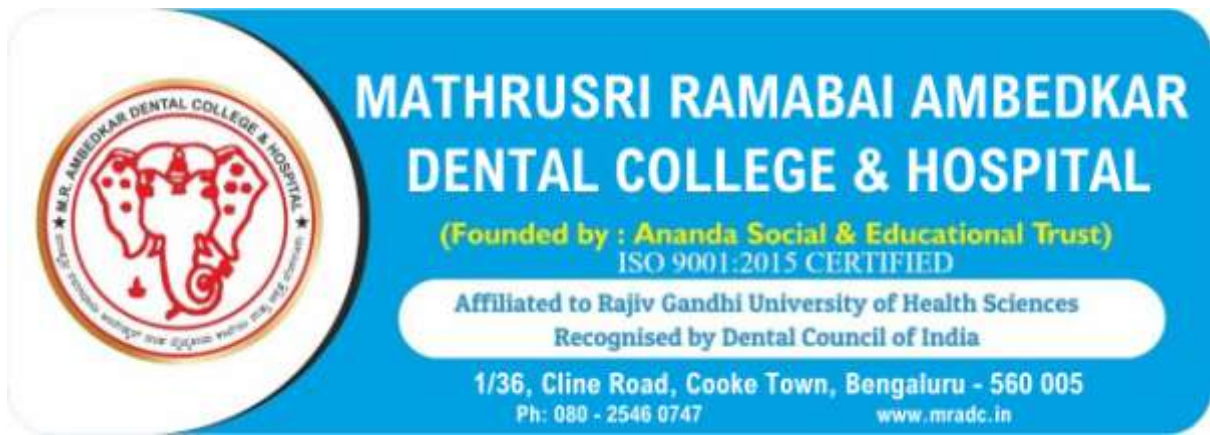

5.1.4 The Institution has an active international student cell to facilitate study in India.

Matrushri Ramabai Ambedkar Dental College and Hospital offers admissions to candidates under both the General and Foreign/NRI categories, provided they meet the eligibility criteria. Seats under the Foreign/NRI category are specifically reserved for foreign nationals, candidates with NRI status, or those sponsored by relatives who hold NRI status. Although our international cell is active and linked on our college website, we have not admitted any international students since 2015 as per Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences directions..

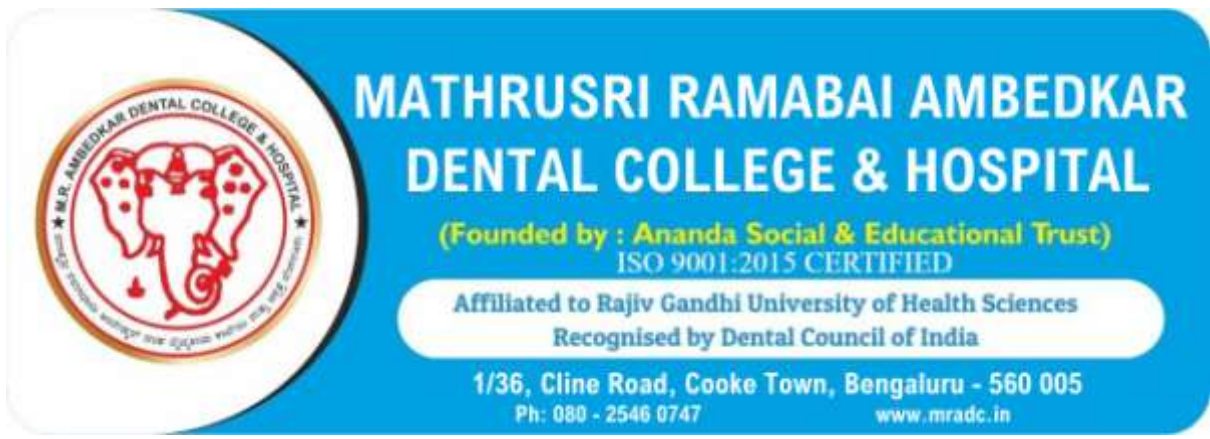
Guidelines for Admission of Foreign/International Students

To be eligible for admission, candidates must be international students, foreign nationals, or non-resident Indians (NRIs). Foreign students must obtain a student visa and secure prior clearance from the Ministry of Home Affairs, along with approval from the Department of Higher Education, Ministry of Human Resource Development, Government of India. This clearance must be reflected on the student visa/research visa endorsed to this institution.

Eligible candidates include foreign citizens, Person of Indian Origin (PIO) Card Holders, Overseas Citizen of India (OCI) holders, NRIs, and NRI-sponsored candidates. The sponsor must be a foreign national or hold NRI status. Only students who have qualified from foreign universities or Boards of Higher Education recognized as equivalent by the 'Association of Indian Universities' (AIU) are eligible for admission.

Admission Procedure

Candidates interested in admission should contact the admission committee at the administrative wing of Ambedkar Dental College and Hospital. To gain admission into the BDS and MDS programs, students must qualify in the NEET examination and obtain a provisional admission offer letter from the academic executive office. This letter is required to secure a student visa, which can be obtained by submitting the provisional admission offer letter to the Indian embassy in the candidate's respective country. Upon receiving the visa, students should report to Ambedkar Dental College and Hospital to complete the admission process.



Required Documents

The following documents must be submitted and verified by the admission committee:

- Pass certificate of the qualifying examination
- Marks list of the qualifying examination
- Original student visa
- Photocopy of the passport, duly attested by a notary

Students are also required to undergo a medical fitness examination and obtain a medical fitness certificate as per government regulations. Those who have studied in a language other than English must provide a valid IELTS/TOEFL score.

Examination and Degree Procedures

The procedures for examination, payment of examination fees, issue of marks lists, issue of passing certificates, and award of degrees will be the same as those for Indian students enrolled in the same courses. The international student's cell is overseen by the principal.

The current students are given special consideration regarding the English medium of instruction. International students receive language support, including English and Kannada classes, to improve communication skills. Remedial classes, peer learning, and mentorship sessions help address their academic and cultural challenges. They are also encouraged to participate in sports, cultural activities, and maintain long-term connections through the alumni association.
