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

- 3. Increase administrative efficiency and reduce manual paperwork.


AREAS OF IMPLEMENTATION

1. College Website

The college website (<u>www.mradc.in</u>) serves as a centralized platform for public communication, featuring important notices, events, committees, departments, research

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publications, policy documents, and more. Web development and management are outsourced by the administration.

2. Student Admission

First-year student admissions are conducted via the Karnataka Examinations Authority (KEA) portal. Subsequent year admissions are managed through the college website.

3. Examinations

MRADCH uses the RGUHS examination software for all exam-related activities, including scheduling, paper submission, and result announcements. The RGUHS portal ensures a streamlined and transparent examination process.

4. Internet Based Communication System

The institution maintains an official email communication system for staff and students. All formal communication must be conducted via institution-provided email IDs.

5. Finance & Accounts

MRADCH employs Tally software for managing finances, including budgeting, payroll, receipts, expenditures, and report generation. E-payment gateways are also integrated, allowing students to pay fees online.


E-GOVERNANCE IN PRACTICE
