We have a credit of 100 plus ongoing research projects and 50plus publications across all departments.



ANNUAL REPORT 2019-20

Welcome to our Annual Report for the academic year 2019-20. I am excited to share this report with you and I am also proud of what our institute has accomplished during this time. Mathrusri Ramabai Ambedkar Dental College & Hospital has successfully completed 35 years spreading quality education and making a remarkable contribution in the field of health care. The Academic and other extension activities are aimed at fulfilling the vision and mission of the college. The main objective is to inculcate skill and knowledge along with ethics, compassion and social responsibility in our students.

Our college aims to be the best dental institution providing education, infrastructure and treatment facilities to cater students and patients. The annual intake started with 40 student's admission and upgraded to 100 student's admission in undergraduate program. 
ADMISSION:

UG & PG admissions take place through NEET and Karnataka Government counseling. MRADCH is one of the most sought after colleges in Karnataka counseling. During this year, the total number of admissions for BDS program was 100 and for MDS it was 38. The current academic year started in the month of September. The Institution has 600 plus students and 100 plus teaching faculty.

COVID – 19 LOCKDOWN:

During the COVID-19 pandemic, MRADCH had to implement various measures to ensure the safety of students, faculty, and patients. Some common practices and recommendations we followed:

Infection Prevention Protocols: We followed strict infection control protocols recommended by health authorities, such as the Centers for Disease Control and
