



Overall the programs were a grand success.




INTERNATIONAL DAY OF THE GIRL CHILD 11/10/2021


INTERNATIONAL WOMEN'S DAY ON 3RD MARCH 2022







BREAST CANCER AWARENESS PROGRAMME ON 20/10/2022






MATHRUSHRI RAMABAI BIRTHDAY CELEBRATION 15TH FEB 2023

Mathrusri Ramabai Ambedkar Dental College and Hospital, Bangalore conducted an anti-ragging orientation program on 12th May 2023


