

At MR Ambedkar Dental College, national and international commemorative days are celebrated with enthusiasm to foster national pride, unity, and cultural heritage.


## **National Festivals/Days and Events:**

- **Independence Day** (August 15): Marked with flag hoisting and the "Swachh Bharath– Swasth Bharat" campaign, aligning with the national drive for cleanliness and health.
- Teacher's Day(September 5): Celebrated with great enthusiasm to honor teachers' contributions to • education, society, and the nation.
- Ambedkar Jayanthi (April 14): Students and staff are inspired to embrace Dr. B.R. Ambedkar's values • in their lives.
- National Voters Day(January 25): Observed with a pledge to vote by students, teaching, and nonteaching staff, followed by an awareness session on the importance of voting.
- **National Doctor's Day(July 1):** Features cultural programs by doctors, with a special tribute to COVID • warriors, including certificates, songs, and dances.
